Protect Yourself from Identity Theft

If you think you may have been the victim of fraud or identity theft, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau offers the following tips for putting a fraud alert on your credit report:

- 1. Contact one of the nationwide credit reporting companies: Equifax, Experian or TransUnion, and ask to place a fraud alert on your credit report.
- 2. Order one free copy of your credit report from each credit reporting company. These free reports do not count as your free annual report from the agency, because you have placed a fraud alert in your report.
- 3. When you get your reports, review them carefully to find any accounts you did not open, outstanding balances that you cannot explain, or incorrect personal information.
- 4. If you find any errors or incorrect information, contact the credit bureau to have it removed by filing a dispute.
